MAI helps local believers create life-transforming Christian books and articles in the heart language of their readers in hard places of the world.

Just before some borders closed in West Africa to control the spread of COVID-19, MAI led a series of productive trainings in Nigeria, Cameroon and Cote d'Ivoire. Some 52 Christian booksellers and publishers attended the marketing workshop in Abidjan—recognizing that Christian books won't be read unless people know they exist and where to find them, thus the importance of marketing to spread the Word.

Most of MAI's upcoming trainings have been postponed due to precautionary measures to control the coronavirus. So in the meantime we are giving increased attention to online training and encouragement for global Christian publishers and writers. Please pray:

- that Christian communicators worldwide will be beacons of faith, hope and love in Christ for those in extreme difficulties from the coronavirus
- that God will sustain and provide for the grassroots Christian publishers hard-hit financially by the pandemic
- God's continued leading in plans for next year's LittWorld 2021 conference in Hungary for 250 participants from 50 countries.

"At this critical time, please pray that global Christian publishers and writers will proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ clearly, their words full of grace, seasoned with salt, in the spirit of Colossians 4:2-4."
