Old Habits or Renewed Minds Genesis 33

It is one thing to encounter God in his transforming power; it is quite another to live in light of the transformation God makes within us.

1.	We tend to fall back into the sinful habits of the past.
2.	We tend to lose our trust in God and respond in fear.
3.	We tend to respond with incomplete obedience.



Three-and-a-half months into the Coronavirus situation here, we have experienced God's faithfulness in many ways. We would like to share three of them with you. First, our church began meeting for worship and fellowship online back in February, so **M** was installed as pastor in a Zoom meeting in April. There are many disadvantages to meeting this way, but one significant advantage is that churches here are learning that we can survive even if our physical meeting spaces are taken away.

Second, in spite of restrictions on travel and on visiting friends, we have been given permission to continue to meet with our friends to homeschool together. **E** and **S** are doing well in this new situation, and after a difficult first half of the year here they have had a relatively stable school experience for the second half with us as their "teachers."

Finally, even with the Coronavirus situation, we have been able to register **T**'s lactation-consulting business, which was the big hurdle on the quest to be able to stay and work here in the long term. These were all situations that we were concerned about just three months ago, and we have seen God's faithfulness in all of them.

Please **pray** for our church and for all the churches in this city. We have been spared a significant outbreak (the first SARS was far worse here), but we have been in lockdown mode since January. This has caused considerable hardship and suffering. Businesses have closed, many have lost jobs, and travel restrictions have meant that several families have been separated for months. Please **pray** that we would know how to meet the needs of our church members and be salt and light for our community here.

For our particular needs, please **pray** that our resident permit process would continue to go smoothly, that **M** would have wisdom starting this new role in this odd time, and that we would continue to be blessed as we seek to learn and grow and serve as a family here.

And, of course, please **pray** that doors would open for us to be able to come back and visit all of you before too long!
