Supported by WSBC since 1989, Lois, and her late husband, Dick, served in South Africa and Mozambique for 38 years. Although officially retired, Lois continues to be a missionary, reaching out with the gospel in her retirement residence.

Lois has been battling pneumonia and was hospitalized on March 29. Her son Jon Morgan has been keeping WSBC up

to date on her condition. Back in late March medical test were performed that confirmed Lois did not have COVID-19, rather she had developed a severe case of pneumonia and sepsis that put her life at risk. Lois received immediate medical treatment from Princeton Hospital in MN.

During the night of March 29 Lois was in the hands of God as her condition was very serious. Jon explained how he watched a miracle unfold as Lois battled back from the brink of eternity. Praise God!

Many people from around the world have been praying for Lois and as Jon has shared "Mom has been greatly encouraged and feeling very loved."

By April Lois' condition had improved, and as of mid-April she has been moved into a long-term nursing care in the same facility where she had been living more independently (Elim Care). Lois has moved into her new room and the family are very encouraged by her continued improvement.
