We are in lockdown here, as are so many places around the world. For the moment, everyone is doing fine and we all seem to be in a good place to weather this crisis. Thank you for your prayers. And know that we are praying for you as well.

It only took five decades (50 years) from when the first translator worked on translation of the New Testament into Daan de Paguh. The first draft was lost in a fire, a second priest started over again, and when he passed away, they could not find the manuscript! Thirteen years ago they decided to try for the third time. With four full-time translators and 49 village churches supporting them, they finally reached the completion of the translation project.

On February 23, we joined with more than 700 Daan de Paguh people as they celebrated the dedication of the New Testament in their mother tongue/heritage language.

This is a testimony to God's faithfulness and the people's perseverance. Praise the Lord!

The light shines the brightest when it is darkest. This global pandemic is giving us Christians an opportunity to shine and reach out to those in need. One way you may want to consider helping out is to host international students who are stranded with nowhere to go as borders to their home countries may have closed.
