1 Peter: The True Grace of God For Today

• PETER, WHO & WHY?

- Please read Peter's Letters. We will not spend too much time focused on who Peter is or was (you may want to do a deeper life and character study of Peter found in the Gospels), but we will let his writing reveal what he wants for us to know.
- 1 Peter 5:12 reveals Peter's purpose for writing. Peter is exhorting and declaring the "True Grace of God." "Stand firm in it."

READ 1 PETER

- After you read the entirety of 1 Peter, spend some time in prayer and reflection considering your need for the True Grace of God and how you should Stand in it today.
 - Your Salvation (1:1-12)
 - o Your Holiness (1:13-2:12)
 - Your Submission (2:13-3:12)
 - Your Suffering (3:14-17)
 - Your Love (4:7-10)
 - o Your Humility (5:5-11)

INTRODUCTION TO THE TRINITY. (1 PETER 1:1-2)

- The Trinity is at work in your Salvation
 - o The Father CHOOSES us in Sovereign Foreknowledge
 - o Jesus Christ REDEEMS us for Loving Obedience
 - Holy Spirit SANCTIFIES us setting us apart to be Holy and to live in Holiness.
- May Grace and Peace be multiplied to you.
- OUR SALVATION & HOPE (1:3-12)

- What are the implications of being Born Again to a Living Hope?
 - o New Life Hope
 - New Family Inheritance
 - New Kind of Faith In Christ with the Spirit of Christ for the Glory of Christ.
- Look at 1:10-12. The Angels long to marvel at God's Gospel plan.
- OUR HOLINESS (1:13-2:12)
 - Be Holy as a Person. (1:16)
 - Our holiness comes from God who is holy, and we are called to enter into holiness with Him.
 - o Conduct your life in holiness. How?
 - Preparing your mind for Battle (action) and on focused alert / vigilant (sober)
 - Be Obedient
 - Don't conform to the patterns and passions of this world. Rom. 12:1&2.
 - Be a Holy People (2:9-12)
 - o Chosen. Royal Priesthood. Holy People.
 - Let everyone see you for who you are and what you do for the glory of the Gospel.

OUR SUBMISSION (2:13-3:12)

- Submit to all authority... for God's Sake.
 - We exercise our freedom through our submission.(2:16) Even during a Pandemic.
- Submission at Work to your Employer (Master)

- Submission in Relationships
 - Marriage to your Husband -- Likewise (in the same way)
 - Mutual submission
 - Sarah in Genesis 18:12. In a playful, everyday moment at the revelation of something impossible in her old age – respect and submission is displayed.
 - Marriage to your Wife -- Likewise (in the same way)
 - Honor. Love. For she is an heir with you of Grace.
 - So your prayers are not hindered.

OUR SUFFERING (3:13-17)

 What is holding you back from living your life completely devoted to what is Good & Right? Fear of suffering?
Suffering that may come from a family member or dear friend or coworker or who?

 Christ suffered for you and we get to share in Christ's sufferings when we suffer for the sake of the Gospel, Good, Right, and True for the glory of God.

OUR LOVE (4:7-11)

- Above all things...
 - o Keep Loving One Another
 - o Love covers a multitude of sins
 - Serve One Another.

• OUR HUMILITY (5:5-11)

- Peter turns his attention towards Pastors and Leaders of the Churches. (Pray for your Pastors.)
- Everyone should be clothed in Humility.
