Your ministry partnership has allowed us to move into new opportunities, helping more Christians bring people around them into scripture. As COVID-19's impact sunk in, we developed two new resources very quickly. In just one month's time, there have been 300 downloads of *4 Bible Discussions in Times of Crisis* and over 150 of the companion facilitator guide, *How to Start Bible Discussions in Times of Crisis*. We are following up with those who got these resources, supporting them to reach out to people they know.

Michele is one of our Q Place catalysts, who started a Q Place group that meets online. Now she provides tech support for others who are also starting groups using Zoom. Michele's group encouraged local medical personnel and first responders by putting together two rounds of treat bags for them.

Q Place discussions aren't about filling in the blanks without much thinking. You have to synthesize; you have to think about the questions and internalize, thinking about what's going on in you. It was perfect for me. The questioning is exactly what I need. I love it."*

God used a Q Place Bible study as a key part in bringing her across the line of faith.
