Lori and Bruce Rowe were married 30 years ago in the WSBC sanctuary. This year also marks 28 years of partnership with WSBC and serving in Chiang Mai Thailand. Serving with Christian Missionary and Alliance's Global Professionals, Bruce brings his computer skills and Lori her nursing and public health background to be loving Thai and ethnic minority people in a variety of ways.



Lori's main role for the last 28 years has been as administrative coordinator for an AIDS education project, which has an orphanage and also a day care for ethnic minority children.

Upon release of the National Thai Church information system, Bruce is now partnering with a wheelchair project where secondhand wheelchairs (from Joni & Friends) are distributed to needy Thai children. Bruce supports this team by providing the reporting tools to track each wheelchair and needy child.

Lori loves being a birth instructor and doula and takes special joy in having her classes come together for a reunion and infant CPR class once all the babies are safely here.

Prayer Points (Transition):

Bruce turned 65 in May and we are making plans for how we can 'run the race' for the next five years before stepping aside to allow others the JOY of serving. The following are items we would appreciate your prayer. Thank you.

For the past 17 years we have owned our home in Thailand. In January we put it up for sale in order to downsize and begin to invest in property here in the States. This is not an ideal time to be selling a house, and we also need wisdom of where we will even want to live once back in the US.

For the past 28 years Lori has served with an American Baptist missionary nurse at the health project. This year Lori will be transitioning to a new ministry helping medical students at the local university.

Starting this year, we have made the decision to be 'home' each year for a period of time (rather than every 2 or 3 years). We want to be more available for Lori's mom. As well, we need wisdom and sensitivity in knowing how to fit into the lives of our adult children.
