Using YoungLife's time-tested methods and life-on-life mentoring, Mark trains and discipled leaders to open new YoungLife clubs and to partner with local churches to reach teens. With a similar model, Liz is introducing the YoungLives ministry, which connects teen moms with adult mentors.

The last few months have certainly presented some interesting challenges for all of us. We pressed on over Zoom and tried as best as we could to continue our ministry in the Heartland Region.

I am excited to announce that over the last few months we opened up two new Young Life Areas in Moline and Bettendorf. I have begun to work very closely with both area directors as they begin their journey in the Quad Cities to reach students who don't know Jesus. We continue to pray for God's leading as we search out new areas to reach students in our region.

Liz is trying to develop a relationship with a multi-ethnic church in Des Moines that we feel will help reach teen moms in the near future. She has begun to form a team of women that will help to mentor teen moms and recently led their first training.

Our plan is to be in the Western Springs area from July 31-August 9. We hope to connect with as many people as possible. We are so grateful for your prayers and support over the years.
