What to expect at WSBC.

As a result of the pandemic (COVID-19), it is necessary to make some changes in how we are used to gathering for worship. We must be intentional in providing reasonable guidelines and precautions for the good of your neighbors who attend and participate in our worship services. As such:

 Please monitor your (and your family members') health and temperature and sanitize your hands before attending an onsite WSBC worship service.

• Please stay home - if you are sick, if you (or any family member) have a fever, if you have recently tested positive for COVID-19 with or without symptoms, or if you have had any close contact with a person who has been confirmed, suspected or is symptomatic of COVID-19.

• Plan to arrive early on Sunday mornings as doors will open 20 minutes before service times. (Service times are 9 and 11AM).

Please wear your own mask while at WSBC.

• Please observe and maintain all social distancing (6 feet), in the sanctuary but also while coming and going. Please, distance 6 feet from others, refrain from handshakes and hugs, avoid fellowshipping in hallways and the narthex, and minimize touching all surfaces.

• Help us accommodate both services. Please, do not linger in the sanctuary or narthex. Fellowship with friends and family outside the building along 45th Street and then walk around the church to the parking lot, bank or wherever you parked vour vehicle.



The Lewis' have been supported by WSBC since 1981. With a worldwide ministry of encouragement, Jon is a frequent guest speaker at Christian conferences for national pastors and leaders. Formerly a missionary pilot in Africa, Jon's years of mission work has equipped him for this coaching ministry.

MISSION FOCUS

Jon continues to be heavily engaged in leadership and ministry network mentoring and consulting all via Zoom meetings. Hardly a day goes by that he is not linking up with someone across the African continent via Zoom or WhatsApp. The good news is that these platforms have actually made African leaders much more accessible than normal. In many ways, more communication and decision-making is happening as a result.

With four planned trips canceled during the past year, Jon has



switched to preparing seminars on Steward Leadership to be available on the Internet. During the past few months, he has completed a participant's workbook and eight video training lessons in English and is now in the middle of a Portuguese version.

That, in turn, will be followed by a lesson series in French. Once again, it appears that COVID has actually spurred a new approach that will result in greater distribution overall.

January is the month that Jon usually teaches courses on missions at Whitworth University. This year teaching the class will be a combination of in-person and online interaction. But, PTL, a record number of students have signed up for the course showing interest in global missions.

Prayer Requests:

For successful completion of translation and video production of the Steward Leader course into both Portuguese and French. Jon is hoping to run some training webinars in early 2021 with local facilitators who want to teach the course.

For ability to fully change and adapt to new teaching restrictions during the Whitworth University January Term course, The Global Christian Movement. Pray too for impact on the students, many of whom might leave the class, challenged to consider a missons career.

For Christians in both Nigeria and Mozambique who are facing severe persecution (and death) by radical Muslims.
