The Q Place website (<u>www.QPlace.com</u>) is more strategically connecting us with Christians who will use our approach and resources to reach people around them.

In the last eight months, 90 Christians have been trained in our 7-session online Q Place Coaching Groups.

We have created two new ways to support Christians on the path to starting groups: (1) bite-sized emailed tips, and (2) a new, online network of support.

We have a new staff member. Lois Darbonne has been a long-time volunteer, and she is now officially on staff with us, working on key projects as our Church Training Developer.

We would greatly appreciate your prayers as we revamp our *9 Arts* website (www.the9Arts.com) and training to reach more churches that can benefit from the tools God has placed in our hands.
