### **Curtis and Esther Reed**

In Nairobi, Kenya, 75% of the population is less than 30 years old. After twelve years of youth and young adult ministry, Curtis, an African-American missionary, and his Kenyan wife, Esther, started a house church in response to the



disconnect he has seen between Christianity and the Kenyan population at large. Engaging young adults using contemporary artistic expressions such as Hip Hop music and poetry, they point their friends to the truth of the gospel and to new life in Christ.

"December 18, 2020, I received notice from the Kenyan government that I had no more than two weeks to leave Kenya. The truth is that I've been having problems with immigration that are long standing and too detailed to go into now. However, I wasn't expecting such short notice to leave. My family and I decided the best thing to do was to come to Chicago for approximately six months, and return to Kenya afterwards. It's been quite an eventful journey, and we keep wondering why God allowed us to come to the States now in the midst of a pandemic, but we learn more and more each day that God's wisdom is infinitely superior to our own. In the short time we've been here, we've had numerous conversations concerning trauma and have become convinced that this is one of the reasons why God has us here, to learn about this crucial area and to incorporate it more firmly within our ministry in Kenya and beyond. We are hoping that the pandemic is eliminated quickly, or that it at least lessens greatly whereby we'll be able to visit you in person.

In the meantime, we would greatly appreciate prayer concerning the following:

- A smooth transition as the children, Museah (grade 4), Kahari (grade3) and Zuberi (Grade 2) attend school in Wheaton.
- Grace as I meet one-on-one with 32 Kenyan disciples each week through social media technology.
- Affordable access to trauma training for Esther while here in the States.
- Favor with the Kenyan government as we prepare to re-enter Kenya later this year."
