Bruce and Lori have ministered in Chiang Mai, Thailand for nearly 29 years, and WSBC has been a part of every one of them. We are grateful for your faithful partnership.

Based in Chiang Mai, a hub for global missions organizations, Bruce and Lori

support missionaries and their Thai church partners. Bruce is an IT database professional who effectively connects organizations to enhance their ministries in Southeast Asia. One of Lori's ministry

highlights is serving as a birthing and lactation coach.

"This past year we traveled to the USA in March, and then were unable to return to Thailand for 11 months. As you are reading this, we will have finished our two-week quarantine in Bangkok and will be resuming ministry in Chiang Mai. We appreciate your prayers for the following areas."

Prayer Points:

- For Bruce--in the next two-three years there are three new systems that will be rolled out. (Asking for an intern to work/learn with/under Bruce)
- Also during these next two-three years, Bruce has about ten older systems (Access) that need to be retired – we need wisdom to help these ministries know how/where to move to.
- Lori has a new visa as an English consultant at the local medical school. Pray for her as she starts to make new relationships.
- Lori is excited to get back to teaching childbirth education classes. With the Thai borders closed and few missionaries coming to deliver in Chiang Mai, the classes have more couples who are not Christian. Please be praying for open hearts to the Good News as they welcome babies.
- We are always grateful for prayer for our three sons and daughter -in-law (Matt-Mark-Allison-Chip).

Did you know? Bruce grew to love the Thai people, while serving in the Peace Corps in the late 1980s.
